



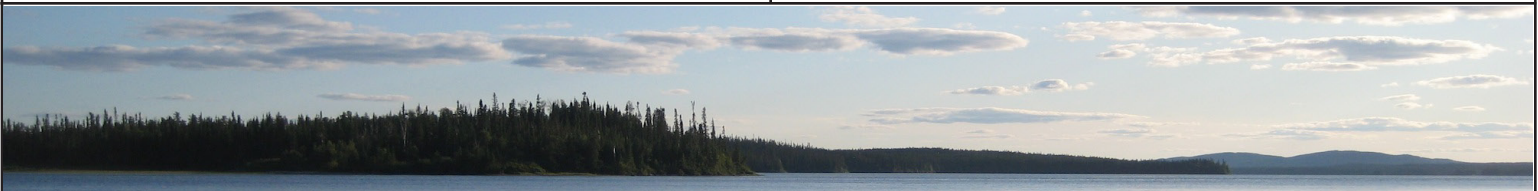

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

FIRST: In order to make sure that Kroka is right for you and your family, we insist that you review the Kroka Parent Handbook prior to submitting your registration. This handbook, along with all other paperwork and forms, can be found at our website, www.kroka.org, or call our office (603) 835-9087 to receive a copy by postal mail.

TO APPLY:

Submit a completed application packet via postal mail, fax, or email. Applications will be processed in the order in which they are received. Your check or credit card will not be deposited until your child is officially accepted into the program. (You will receive an email or a telephone notifying you of your child's acceptance into the program.) The paperwork packet will be due by May 1st. Late applications (after May 1st) must include the complete paperwork packet, as well as the full tuition payment or scholarship fee.

FINANCIAL NOTES:

If you are submitting your application AFTER May 1st, the FULL TUITION amount is DUE AT TIME OF REGISTRATION along with your registration form.

PACKING LISTS, FIRST-DAY SPECIFICS and other helpful information will be emailed to you during the month of May.

AFFORDING KROKA: Kroka Expeditions is committed to allowing participation for everyone, regardless of ability to pay. We are able to sustain this as long as every family consciously pays as much as they can afford. Please note these options:

SLIDING SCALE FEE: Open to everyone. This is an honor-based form of financial aid.

GENERAL SCHOLARSHIPS: Scholarship applications should be completed and mailed in with your registration form and must be accompanied by a \$100 deposit. Applications are available at our website, or by calling our office. Eligibility is based on income and circumstances. Your deposit will be refunded if you are not satisfied with the scholarship amount.

MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP FUNDS: Noah Simring and Julie Seiler Memorial Scholarship Funds: Two special scholarships are available annually to qualified students. For more information and guidelines, please see our website or call the office for details.

PAYMENT PLANS: Payment plans can be arranged by calling our office.

PROVIDING OPPORTUNITIES FOR OTHERS: Kroka Expeditions was founded on the important principle of serving children and families regardless of income. Each summer, we contribute more than \$50,000 in financial aid to families. In the spirit of supporting Kroka's mission, we invite you to make a tax-deductible donation to our scholarship fund. There is space for this on the tuition form. All the money in our scholarship fund offsets the tuition reductions on our sliding scale fee and provides additional financial aid that is needed by families beyond the sliding scale. Again, all donations to the scholarship fund are fully tax-deductible. Thank you!

CANCELLATION POLICY: We will refund full tuition (less a \$100 administrative fee) for any cancellations that occur prior to May 1st. As of May 1st, all tuition payments are non-refundable. In some cases (such as cancellation due to unexpected injury) tuition may be credited toward the following year.

REFUNDS: There are no refunds issued for students dismissed from the program due to illness or disciplinary reasons, or for students who choose to withdraw early from the program already in session. If a student must leave due to an injury incurred while on the program, a prorated portion of the tuition will be refunded.
